

Ministry Update

In May the team were invited to the Garden Party at Buckingham Palace to celebrate CFC being awarded the Queen's Award for Voluntary Service (2020) and also our Founder Stephen Crawford being awarded the B.E.M. - what a privilege and blessing for Christian work to be recognised and what a lovely day we had!

On return we were straight into our summer season with summer camps in churches throughout N Ireland, a number of which were first time camps and with return visits in the diary for 2023. The in late August we travelled further afield to Cordoba, Spain – a very welcomed and worthwhile trip since our time there in 2019. We ran 4 camps daily for a period of 1 week with a team of 12 coaches and helpers and had opportunities to meet the local officials of each town who are delighted with the work of CFC in Spain – so much so we have been asked to travel next year again for 2 weeks. Our partners in Cordoba are Francis and Nathalie Arjona. Francis has been the Spanish field national Director of ECM Spain for 22 years, he is the pastor of the Church in Pozoblanco. Pray for Francis and Nathalie - their church is one of the very few evangelical churches in an area of 100,000 people. They do incredible outreach and are seeing many accept lesus as their Saviour.

New Full-time coaches and intern - Our full time team has two new coaches - Kyle Crawford, full-time coach (more from Kyle on the second page), Louis who was our intern last year. In September 2022, Niall joined our a team an an intern. Niall has been an under 18 player for CFC and so has a great heart for the work and we are delighted to have him on board.

Full time team - We very much value our Monday morning's - a time to spend as a full time team in prayer, Bible study and planning. These are rich times, something that we have always done since the Ministry began 18 years ago. The first half of 2022 we studied leadership and in Sept we began our study on Vision.
